Interpret basic biochemical, hematological, and urine test results. 5. Makes a differential diagnosis by evaluating the anamnesis, physical examination findings and the results of basic diagnostic tests together. 6. It organizes the medical records of its patients (patient files, epicrisis, etc.). 7. Counts the risk factors of childhood diseases that are common in the society, and encourages individuals and society in their prevention. Informs. 8. Performs teamwork with physicians and other health personnel. 9. Communicates effectively with the patient, their relatives and other healthcare personnel. 10. Conduct literature review in line with their needs in order to update their medical knowledge, critically evaluate and present literature findings. 11. Performs diagnostic and interventional applications (intravenous and intramuscular injection, venous and arterial blood sampling, vascular access, nasogastric catheter and urethral catheter insertion, urine, blood and throat culture, catheter care and dressing) under supervision. 12. Interns' questions about internship Answered.</p> <p>Daily working conditions: Interns working in the Department of Child Health and Diseases;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The service rotates in four areas: neonatal intensive care unit, polinics and emergency department. 2. It is ready in the working units at the beginning of the working hours. 3. Reads the legislation, procedures and principles related to his/her duty in the hospital and the department he/she works in, fully complies with them and ensures their implementation. <p>Rules of operation in the service:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Interns; Participates in general visits. Obtains and presents the necessary information about patients. 2. Assists in the monitoring of patients admitted to the Pediatrics service from admission to discharge is responsible for being responsible. 3. Performs the first examination for the preliminary diagnosis of the patient who is taken to the service. Records the anamnesis and vital signs in the file. 4. Exchanges views with the faculty member / specialist about the examinations that may be required for the patient. After the approval of the faculty member / specialist physician, the examinations are requested. 5. It does not ask for consultation, it ensures that the consultation documents are arranged. 6. It does not request an examination without the approval of the faculty member / specialist physician. 7. Patients who are decided to be kept under observation in the service; It ensures that vital signs are followed. 8. Collaborates with the on-call physician/education officer/instructor in the planning of the patient's treatment and emergency care and assists in the interventions under his supervision. 9. The department participates in the Intern Education and Training Program. 10. It fully complies with the working principles of the hospital and the department, ensures the organization and order of the place where it works, protects the materials it uses, and completes its work on time. 11. Establishes good relations with the hospital and department employees and carries out their duties in cooperation and harmony.
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
