<b>Purpose of the Internship</b>	At the end of the General Surgery internship, interns; To be able to effectively carry out the history, physical examination, diagnosis and differential diagnosis processes of surgical patients, to communicate effectively with patients and their relatives, to follow up patients during the period before and after surgical treatment, to accompany all medical interventions to be made to the patients for whom they are responsible, and It is aimed to learn the appropriate approach to surgical patients that may be encountered after graduation.
<b>Learning Objectives of the Internship</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Performs surgical history and physical examination in adult patients.</li> <li>2. Know the diagnostic tools and use them appropriately.</li> <li>3. Surgery diagnoses patients and conducts differential diagnosis.</li> <li>4. Explains and applies intervention priorities in acute abdomen, bleeding and shock.</li> <li>5. Applies the general principles of approach to the patient with abdominal pain complaints.</li> <li>6. Performs breast examination, explains the diagnostic approach in breast diseases and counts diagnostic tools.</li> <li>7. Explains and applies the applications of asepsis and antiseptics.</li> <li>8. Knows the importance of obtaining consent from patients before surgical interventions and obtains consent.</li> <li>9. Performs minor surgical treatment applications.</li> <li>10. Explain the signs and symptoms of benign and malignant diseases of the gastrointestinal and endocrine systems, and can lead to appropriate diagnostic tools and expert opinion.</li> <li>11. Explain wound healing processes and principles of wound care.</li> <li>12. Applies the principles of emergency approach in trauma patients.</li> <li>13. Applies the principles of fluid resuscitation.</li> <li>14. Explain the indications for consultation.</li> <li>15. Patient Turnover Visits: Every day, clinical and laboratory discussions of transferred patients in General Surgery wards active participation of intruders.</li> <li>2. Participation in the Intern Education and Training Program (and/or Medical Specialization Training Program) organized on the days and times specified within the General Surgery internship.</li> </ol>
<b>Assessment of Internship Evaluation Method</b>	<p>Interns; Education according to the criteria of the practices in the intern report card, attitudes and behaviors to be exhibited</p> <p>It is evaluated by the responsible person and the Head of the Department.</p>
<b>Work of the Internship Terms/Rules</b>	<p><b>Working Conditions in General Surgery Service and Outpatient Clinics:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The units of study and the rotation schedule are determined before the internship starts.</li> <li>2. Working units; general surgery service, operating room, general surgery outpatient clinic.</li> <li>3. It is ready in the working units at the beginning of the working hours.</li> <li>4. During the internship, each intern takes 8 to 10 shifts.</li> <li>5. During the shift, he works under the physician on duty.</li> <li>6. During the shift, he takes part in the operations in all units.</li> <li>7. Together with the physician on duty and in the evaluation of newly admitted patients in inpatient follow-up, treatment and care procedures, preparation of the new inpatient, assisting the surgical operation, patient evaluation in the emergency department and evaluation of newly admitted patients. takes an active role under its supervision.</li> </ol> <p><b>a) Service work</b> Performs the following applications in the presence of the responsible physician: Preop-postoperative patient follow-up, drain, catheter follow-up and evaluation, vascular access, arterial blood gas removal and evaluation, case presentation, foley catheter insertion, epicrisis writing, nasogastric catheter insertion, local anesthesia, primary suturing, assisting surgical operation, wound care (dressing/irrigation), simple surgical intervention (superficial abscess drainage, etc.), sampling for culture, prescribing, rectal touching, X-ray (PAAC/ADBG/DUSG) evaluation, history-physical examination, patient preparation with differential diagnosis-pre-diagnosis, enema application, burn care.</p> <p><b>b) Outpatient studies</b> Performs the following applications in the presence of the responsible physician: History-physical examination-patient preparation with differential diagnosis, preop-postoperative patient follow-up, drain, catheter follow-up and evaluation, case presentation, foley catheter insertion, epicrisis writing, local anesthesia, primary suture, wound care (dressing/irrigation), simple surgical intervention (superficial abscess drainage), sampling for culture, prescribing, rectal touching, X-ray (PAAC/ADBG/DUSG) evaluation and burn care.</p>
