Learning Objectives of the Internship	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. He takes an anamnesis from the patient. 2. Performs a systemic physical examination. 3. According to the results of the anamnesis and physical examination, it determines the pathological symptoms and signs, creates preliminary diagnoses, basic diagnosis He asks for his tests. 4. Interpret basic biochemical, hematological, and urine test results. 5. Makes a differential diagnosis by evaluating the anamnesis, physical examination findings and the results of basic diagnostic tests together. 6. It organizes the medical records of its patients (patient files, epicrisis, etc.). 7. Can diagnose and follow up pregnancy. 8. Performs routine pregnancy examination. 9. Recognizes the urgent and complicated situations of pregnancy, organizes the referral to the upper center when necessary, defines the situations that require treatment and what needs to be done in emergency conditions. 10. Counts the symptoms of benign and malignant gynecological diseases, examination findings, selects the tests to be performed, explains and interprets the treatment methods. It decides on the patient who needs to be referred to the higher center. 11. Defines infertility, counts and defines the basic examinations to be performed in infertility, and the appropriate treatment approach according to the results. expresses. 12. Explains the basic concepts of contraception, enumerates the advantages, disadvantages and contraindications of contraceptive methods, advises patients on contraception options. 13. Define normal labor, distinguish between false labor pains and true labor, predict whether labor is progressing normally in labor, identify fetal distress before or during labor, and manage emergencies. 14. Explain peripartum and postpartum abnormal bleeding and emergencies, decide how to manage these conditions.
