## **I. Our History**

The Sani Konukoğlu Foundation was established with the Law No. 6492 published in the Official Gazette No. 28681 dated June 18, 2013 and “SANKO University” became ready to serve. Faculty of Health Sciences Nursing Department started education in 2014 and gave its first graduates in 2018. In addition, the Department of Nursing started to serve within the Graduate Education Institute in 2015 and gave its first graduates in 2017. Education is still continuing in the same program.

In our department, the applications of vocational courses are mainly carried out at SANKO University Sani Konukoğlu Practice and Research Hospital, which started operating in 1996 and signed a Joint Use Protocol (Affiliation) in cooperation with SANKO University in 2017. At the same time, the applications of vocational courses according to the content of the courses; It is carried out in Vocational Skills Laboratory, Public Hospitals, Family Health Centers, Community and Mental Health Centers, Community Health Centers, KETEM and Nursing Homes.

SANKO University has a Quality Management System in order to ensure traceability, sustainability and continuous improvement, and to carry out institutionalism among academic/administrative staff in accordance with the conditions of "TS EN ISO 9001: 2015 Quality Management System Standard".

### **SANKO University Sani Konukoğlu Practice and Research Hospital**

Sani Konukoğlu, who experienced the difficulties caused by the lack of a modern health center equipped with modern technology in Gaziantep, started the establishment of SANKO University Sani Konukoğlu Practice and Research Hospital in 1993 and continued its work until he passed away in 1994. SANKO University Sani Konukoğlu Application and Research Hospital, which was put into operation in August 1996 by his family, who realized the ideal of Sani Konukoğlu, is one of the largest health institutions brought to our country today.

The TS-EN ISO-9001 Quality System Certificate studies at the hospital, which is managed with a contemporary hospital management approach at national and international standards, were concluded in April 1998 and became the sixth hospital in Turkey to receive this certificate by TSE and the fourth among private hospitals. TS EN ISO 14001 Environmental Management Systems Certificate, ISO 45001:2018 Occupational Health in SANKO University Sani Konukoğlu Practice and Research Hospital, which is the first hospital in our country to receive the TS 13811 Hygiene and Sanitation Management Systems Certificate from the Turkish Standards Institute (TSE) in 2020. and Safety Management System Certificate and TS-ISO-EN 9001:2015 Quality Management System Certificate.

In the hospital, which has become the address of high quality in health, Emergency Service, Biochemistry, Pathology and Medical / Clinical Microbiology Laboratories, Radiology, Nuclear Medicine, Cardiovascular Surgery, Organ Transplantation Center, Nephrology, Hematology, Therapeutic Apheresis Center, General Surgery, Neurosurgery, Pediatric Surgery, Internal Medicine, Gastroenterology, Endocrinology, Otorhinolaryngology, Pediatrics, Medical Oncology, Pediatric Hematology, Cardiology, Chest Diseases, Urology, Orthopedics and Traumatology, Infectious Diseases, Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation, Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery, Ophthalmology, Gynecology and Obstetrics, Neurology, Psychiatry, Child and Adolescent Psychiatry, Thoracic Surgery, Dermatology,

Sleep Laboratory, Obesity Center, Peritoneal Dialysis Center, Pulmonary Rehabilitation Center, and Assisted Reproductive Therapy (Tube) Baby) Center, expert diagnosis and treatment methods are applied.

In the face of intense demand, the construction of the additional building of the hospital, which was started in 2006, was completed in November 2009, in the 60,750 square meter working area, Coronary Intensive Care, Cardiovascular Intensive Care, each of which is under the supervision of doctors and nurses 24 hours a day, in which all kinds of life support are provided and the vital functions of the patients are constantly monitored. , Surgical Intensive Care, and Neonatal Intensive Care (36 fixed incubators, 3 transport incubators) units reached a total bed capacity of 114. There are 6 examination rooms, 15 observation beds, 2 fully equipped intervention rooms, 1 resuscitation room, Gynecology, Otorhinolaryngology, Pediatrics, Orthopedics and Traumatology examination rooms in the Emergency Service. The hospital has a capacity of 600 beds in two buildings, 2 fully equipped ambulances, 1000 personnel specialized in their fields, 120 polyclinic rooms, waiting rooms, a hall where all kinds of national and international meetings can be held, a cafeteria, a closed car park for 225 vehicles and an open car park for 50 vehicles in the basement. It has the capacity to respond to every need of its relatives.

SANKO University Sani Konukoğlu Practice and Research Hospital, which has been serving the people of the region since 1996, has crowned its service quality by signing the Cooperation and Common Use Protocol (Affiliation) with SANKO University, which was established in 2013, and has become an application and research center for SANKO University.

## **ii. University Location**

Located in one of the most central points of Gaziantep, SANKO University's central campus consists of the university main building, SANKO University Sani Konukoğlu Practice and Research Hospital.



### iii. Education

The duration of education in the nursing department is four years and the language of education is Turkish. Students graduating from high schools and equivalent schools are accepted with the numerical score they get from the Higher Education Institutions Examination. During the education process, theoretical and applied courses including eight departments related to the nursing profession, basic sciences (Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, Pharmacology, etc.) and social sciences (Psychology, etc.) are given. In addition, there are elective courses that our students can choose every semester.

### 3.1. Courses and ECTS Credits

Lesson plans have been prepared in order to show the distribution of the courses offered in our department over the years/semesters. Academic Crediting Total System (ECTS) is applied in the programs. ECTS is the sum of the credits of the courses that a student will take in a semester. The student is required to take a maximum of 31 ECTS during the semester and 60 ECTS annually. The courses are collected in two parts as compulsory and elective courses. In order to graduate from the department, students must take and succeed in the specified courses. 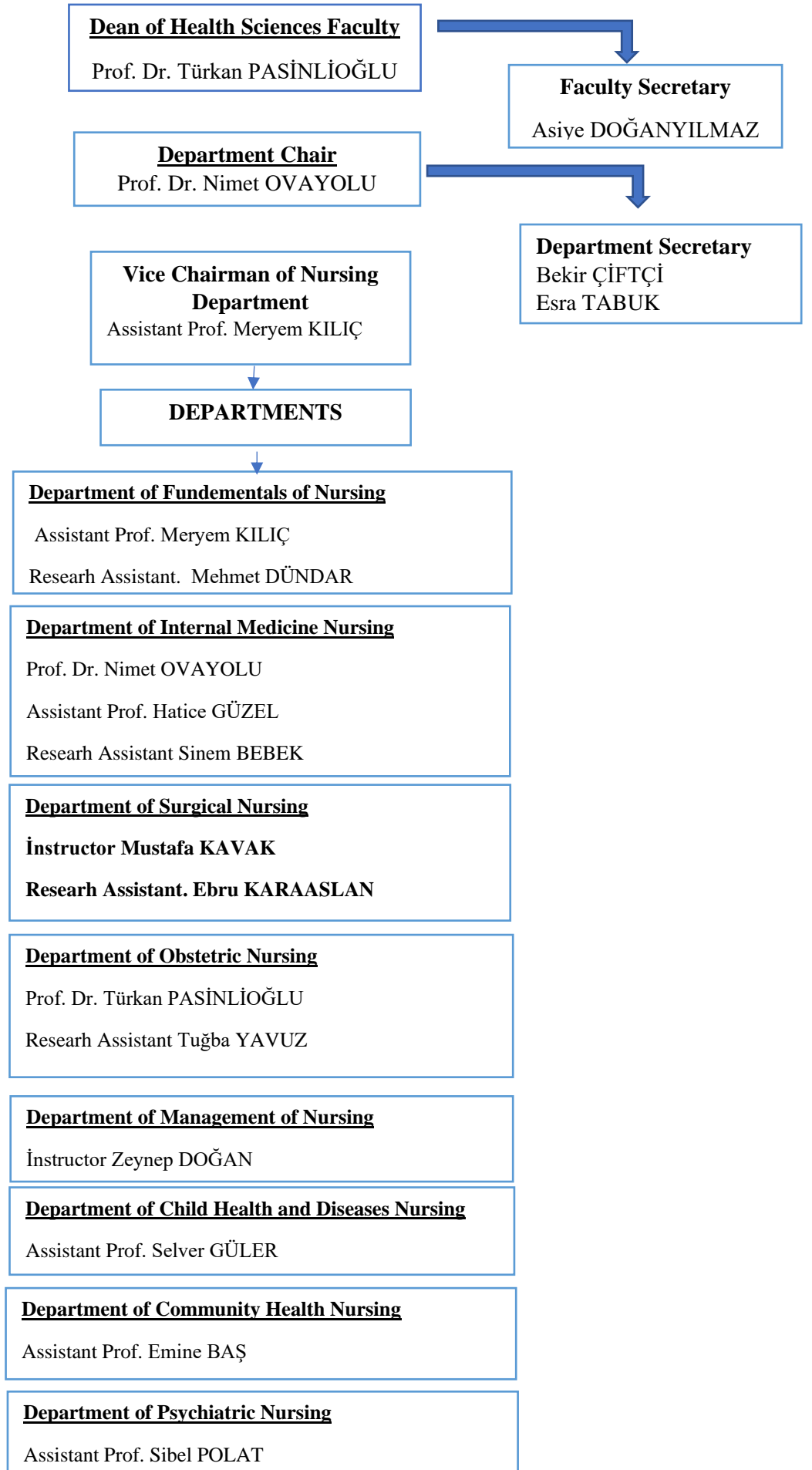

## **xii. Laboratories**

### **12.1. Vocational Skills Laboratory**

In gaining basic professional skills, it is important to make all applications on models before meeting with the patient, in order for our students to feel competent and safe. For this reason, there are various areas in the vocational skills laboratory where our students can practice their skills. There are patient beds and models in these areas. With these models, injection, urinary catheter, nasogastric tube, enema applications, blood pressure measurement, movement and exercises, patient transfer, transfusion of blood and blood products, various drugs can be applied

to the eyes, ears and skin. In this laboratory, applications for professional skills are carried out mainly by the students of the Faculty of Medicine and the Department of Nursing. Our students' learning is reinforced with the applications in this laboratory after taking the theoretical lessons before going to the clinic.





## **12.2. Simulation Laboratory**

Simulation is the fictionalization and animation of the disease, condition, event or technical skills that exist in reality. Our Faculty of Medicine and Nursing Department students teach clinical and professional skills practice in our Simulation Laboratories. The Simulation Laboratory consists of three parts; In the first and second sections, many patient profiles that can be encountered in the realistically designed emergency department and in all branches can be simulated. For these applications, there are three simulator models called SimMan, SimJunior and SimBaby. Our students learn about all kinds of diseases or conditions (heart attack, cardiac arrest, respiratory failure, trauma, etc.) that they may encounter in the clinic, individually or as a team, on these simulators. All the applications made in our laboratories are recorded with audio and video, and after the application, our students are given feedback on the recordings and discussed where they made mistakes. In the third section, there is a room for simulated patients (who plays the role of a patient trained in a disease), where anamnesis and communication with the patient are carried out.





### **12.3. Anatomy Laboratory**

Human anatomy examines the body's structure, organs, systems and their structural relations with each other, namely their neighborhoods and functional properties. Training in the laboratory is reinforced with applications made on cadavers and models, and virtual techniques and simulations brought by today's technologies, after giving basic theoretical information about human anatomy. In our anatomy laboratory, which has an area of more than 250 m<sup>2</sup>, there is a cadaver storage and fixation unit, a model room, a dissection room and a classroom. There are two cadaver pools and two morgue cabinets in the cadaver unit.



#### **12.4. Computer Skills Laboratory**

There are 80 student computers and two smart boards connected to the main computer in our Digital Lab. Our students can use our modern laboratory, which has high-speed internet, outside of the classroom. Not only undergraduate but also postgraduate students can work in this laboratory with our instructors in their thesis studies, projects and researches.
